2) This certificate is being given on the condition that the School will fulfill the norms and conditions laid down by Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi. and the Maharashtra Nursing Council, Mumbai and will not employ / engage any teacher from the Government Nursing Colleges / School except their retirement and superannuation, and on the condition that no admissions shall be made without approval of Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi.
